

BIKE RENTAL AGREEMENT

concluded on, in Wisła, between Skolnity Ski & Bike Park with its registered office in Wisła, 43-460 Wisła, ul. 1 Maja 61, hereinafter referred to as the RENTAL SHOP

and

§ 1.

The subject of the agreement is bicycle rental:

§ 2.

The security deposit is zlotys. The deposit is collected as a pre-authorisation on the payment card in accordance with §3 of the Rental Shop Regulations.

§ 3.

Dates:

The bicycle is rented to the Renter on.....at

The bicycle shall be returned to the rental shop on.....at.....

§ 4.

1. The Rental Shop hands over the bicycle to the Renter for use in a condition suitable for the agreed use (in visibly proper technical condition). The technical condition of the rented bicycle has been accepted by the Renter and checked by an employee of the Rental Shop.
2. The Renter declares that they have visually inspected the bicycle and have found no visible technical defects.
3. The bicycle shall be returned in an undeteriorated condition, excluding normal wear resulting from proper use.
4. The Renter is obliged to report to the staff any noticed damage or defects in the bicycle at the time of its issue and return.

§ 5.

The Renter undertakes to use the bicycle in accordance with its intended purpose and at the same time bears full responsibility for any events and damage arising from its use.

§ 6.

1. The Renter shall be liable for damage resulting from improper use of the rented bicycle and shall also cover all costs related to the repair of the bicycle in accordance with an individual valuation made at the Rental Shop based on market prices.
2. The provision of section 1 does not apply if the client purchases the service option (PLN 19 - STANDARD, SUPERIOR bicycles, PLN 29 - PREMIUM bicycles) in accordance with the terms of the service option described in the price list.
3. The Rental Shop reserves the right to refuse to accept the bicycle when its damage is so significant that its repair becomes uneconomical. In such a case, the Renter undertakes to cover costs corresponding to the market value of the rented bicycle on the day the damage is found, according to the valuation presented by the Rental Shop based on market prices.

§ 7.

Fees for bicycle rental are calculated according to the price list. The rental agreement may be concluded for full hours or an agreed time.

§ 8.

With regard to liability for accidents and damage to the bicycle, the provisions of § 5 of the Regulations shall apply.

§ 9.

For matters not regulated in the rental agreement and the Rental Shop Regulations, the provisions of the Civil Code shall apply.

§ 10.

The agreement has been drawn up in two identical copies, one for each party.

§ 11.

Information concerning GDPR is included in the Rental Shop Regulations.

§ 12.

By signing the Agreement, the Renter confirms that:

1. has received and read the Rental Shop Regulations and the Price List.
2. has been instructed on the rules for safe operation of the bicycle.
3. acknowledges that mountain riding involves sports risk and accepts responsibility for damage resulting from their own mistakes or lack of skills.
